SI Re strengthens its ILS team with Simon Parten as ILS Portfolio Manager

Simon Parten joins SI Re on 1 June 2026. His extensive experience in the portfolio allocation of catastrophe bonds, collateralised reinsurance, quota shares and leveraged facilities as well as his strong technology and quantitative edge will benefit SI Re's growing ILS book.

Simon Parten joins from Schroder Capital ILS, where he most recently served as Senior Underwriter & Analyst for the firm's extensive ILS portfolio. His career spans pricing actuary roles at Zurich Financial Services, positions at Allianz Risk Transfer and Towers Watson, and early experience with Tindall Riley at Britannia P&I. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Mathematics from Durham University and a Diploma in Actuarial Studies from the UK Institute and Faculty of Actuaries.
